Report: Workshop on Interview Preparation, Guidelines, and Practice

Thursday, October 12, 2023

The Centre for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D) in association with the Faculty of Pharmacy, Integral University, organized a workshop on October 12th, which was aimed at final year students pursuing B.Pharm, M.Pharm, and Pharma.D. Mr. Gyani Pularu's extensive industry experience and insights greatly enriched the learning experience for the participants. He emphasized the importance of listing strengths, areas of improvement, recent achievements, and a thorough review of one's resume as initial preparation steps before attending an interview. Techniques to manage nervousness before and during an interview were discussed, providing students with practical strategies to handle anxiety effectively. He also discussed common interview questions and mistakes. He elaborated the need for thorough preparation and avoidance of common blunders such as inappropriate attire, lack of preparation, negative attitude, and poor articulation.

The workshop was efficiently coordinated by **Dr. Kuldeep Singh**, Faculty of Pharmacy, **Dr. Sufia Rehman**, CCG&D and **Ms. Huma Iqbal**, CCG&D ensuring a seamless and productive event for the participants.
