

Report: Visit to Center for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D) by First-Year Students under the Student Induction Program (SIP)

Integral University organized a Student Induction Program (SIP) for all first-year students across various branches. The Center for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D) took the initiative to arrange departmental visits for these students from August 1, 2024, to August 3, 2024. The aim was to enhance their understanding of career development and progression opportunities. The visits were conducted in Academic Block E (Ground floor-CCG&D Hall) in coordination with the Heads of Departments (HODs) from different faculties.

The visit commenced with a warm welcome from **Dr. Nilanjan Mukherji (Director-CCG&D)**, who addressed students from various branches in multiple batches, with the visits scheduled across different dates and times.
