With the increasing **digitalization** of our world, **cyber attacks** are becoming more frequent and sophisticated. Staying informed and up-to-date is crucial to protecting ourselves from these threats.

This month, we focus on key **email security** practices that can help safeguard your personal information and prevent phishing attacks.

To enhance your email security, **always respond only to official email IDs**, verifying that the sender's address is from a recognized domain. **Carefully check the domain name**, as phishing attempts often use deceptive variations to impersonate trusted organizations. **Avoid clicking on suspicious links** or downloading unfamiliar attachments, and **immediately report any suspicious emails to the IT department**. Lastly, never share **sensitive information such as login credentials** via email, as university officials will never ask for them.

CLICK SMART: DEFEND AGAINST EMAIL SCAMS

1. RESPOND ONLY TO OFFICIAL EMAIL IDS

Always verify the sender's email address. Make sure you are responding only to official university email addresses or recognized domains.

2. CHECK THE DOMAIN NAME CAREFULLY

Before responding to any email, double-check the domain name. Phishing emails often use similar-looking domain names to impersonate trusted organizations.

3. BEWARE OF SUSPICIOUS LINKS AND ATTACHMENTS

Avoid clicking on any unfamiliar links or downloading attachments from unknown or suspicious sources.

4. REPORT SUSPICIOUS EMAILS

If you receive an email that seems suspicious or out of place, do not respond or interact with it. Report it immediately to the IT department for further investigation.

5. KEEP YOUR CREDENTIALS SECURE

Never share your login details or sensitive information through email. University officials will never ask for your password or personal information via email.
