Important Notes:

- In addition to scheduled remedial classes, it may also be conducted regularly as per the need of the students and their attendance must be recorded at the portal.
- For advance learners, enrichment classes/activities should also be conducted regularly and their attendance must be recorded at the portal.
- Students who does NOT attain the minimum required attendance as per the University guidelines will NOT be allowed to appear in the Mid-semester/ End Semester/Annual examinations.
- Students are advised to deposit their fee at the earliest to avoid the long queues and late fine.
- To avoid late find, Semester registration must be done by the students before the due date.
- Admit Card for appearing in Semester-End (Odd) Examination-2024-25 shall be given after deposition of the pending dues, if any.
- Students, who wish to appear in the Improvement examination need to apply for the same for individual subjects after paying the requisite fee.
- Dean/Director/Managing Committee should ensure that half of the entire syllabus is completed before the Mid Semester.
- Students have to appear in the Mid Semester which will be tentatively held in the mid of the semester.
- Teachers are required to take Short Term Tests, Quizzes and Assignments during the teaching of any topic or after its completion besides the above Mid Semester test.
- Dean/Director/Managing Committee should also ensure that minimum 95 instructional days and 15 examination days are available during the semester.
If required, extra classes should be arranged in holidays to make-up for the same.
- Mid-Semester Examination copies to be shown to the students within one week of the completion of examination.
- Changes, if required, will be displayed on the notice board from time to time.
