Important Note:

1. Student who do NOT attain the minimum required attendance as per University guidelines will NOT be allowed to appear in the Mid Semesters/End Semester/Annual examination
2. Students who wish to appear in the Improvement Exam, need to apply for the same for individual subjects. The fee for the Improvement Exam is Rs. 2000/- per subject.
3. Mid Semester exam copies to be shown to the students within one week of the completion of exams.
4. Director/Managing Committee should ensure that half of the entire syllabus is completed before the Mid Semester test.
5. Students have to appear in the Mid Semester test which will be tentatively held in the mid of the semester. Teachers are required to take Short Term Tests and Quizzes during the teaching of any topic or after its completion besides the above Mid Semester test.
6. Director/Managing Committee should also ensure that minimum 95 instructional days and 15 examination days are available during the semester. If required, extra classes should be arranged in holidays to make-up for the same.
7. No student will be allowed to appear in the end semester examination who does not attain the minimum required attendance as per ordinance of the university.
8. Changes, if required, will be displayed on the notice board from time to time.
9. Admit Card for appearing in End Semester Examination would only be given to students after deposition of second installment of the fee.
