**Brief Report on Communal Harmony Week 2023 observed at Integral University,
Lucknow**

Integral University observes Communal Harmony Week every year during 19th to 25th November under the Aegis of Office of Dean, Students' Welfare and various departments to spread a message of peace, harmony and National integration among its students and faculty/staff members. The program was organized as per the directive of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, under its National Foundation for Communal Harmony, New Delhi. During the week-long program, various departments were instructed to conduct essay/painting/debate competitions on the theme of communal harmony for sensitizing their students. A donation drive was also organized through distribution of Flag Stickers, which ended in observing "Flag Day" on 24th November. The program culminated with the conduct of a cultural evening on the theme, which was organized by Cultural and Literary Committees, Integral University on 1st Dec 2023 at its campus. Students and faculty members of the university participated in the same and enjoyed a melodious musical evening organized by students of High Note Music Society (HNMS) fostering peace and national integration.

The programme began with an introduction about the purpose of the musical evening by Ms Grace, who also anchored the program. The first performance was a prayer by the choir of High Note Music Society "Teri Hai Zamin Tera Aasma" generating a soulful beginning of the event, this was followed by a duet "I love my India" by Jaya Sarkar and Ahmar. Next in the sequence was a musical drama presented by students of B.Ed. First year, Ayesha Alvi, Maimoona Tahir, Nadiya Khan, Shoa Saquib, Raniya Siddiqui, Daniya Siddiqui and Km. Sheeren, on the theme and importance of communal harmony as a shadow play by the students and guided by Dr Geetika Nidhi, effectively conveying the message through their excellent performance. A group song "Aisa Desh Hai Mera" was also presented by Choir of High Note Music Society captivated the audience and created a milieu of harmony and guild. To glorify the motherland, Jaya Sarkar sang the Sanskrit version of "Vande Mataram" which was appreciated by all present. The talented faculty of the integral university also contributed to the event in which Dr. Shailendra Kumar, Dr. Suman P. Ranjan and Dr. Noorain Anas showcased the mesmerizing performance through their melodious songs.
