

Integral University Scholarship and Fee Waiver Scheme 2017-18

Integral University launches an Integral University Scholarship and Fee Waiver Scheme from the academic session 2017-18. This scheme primarily gives an equal opportunity to meritorious students of class 12th who could not afford higher education in view of financial constraints.

The University has also approved the provision of **Staff Quota**, wherein Staff Members including their spouse and children will get 25% waiver in the Tuition Fees.

The university has also approved the provision of **Siblings Quota** wherein siblings of all the students currently enrolled in the University will get 25% waiver in the Tuition Fees.

In addition to that, the University has also introduced **Sports Quota** to promote sports and attract sportspersons who shall represent the University at state and national level sports events, and **SC/ST/OBC Quota** for the purpose of giving equal opportunity to students who belong to the reserved category. Under the Sports and SC/ST/OBC Quotas, a relaxation of 5% will be provided in the eligibility criteria for admission.
