A Brief Report on

3-Days Workshop cum Counselling Session on "Stand Up Against Street Harassment" under Mission Shakti Vishesh Abhiyan Phase-III organized by the University Polytechnic and Women Grievance Cell, Integral University Lucknow in collaboration with Breakthrough.

As per the directives of Higher Education Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh, the University and Women Grievance Cell, Integral University Lucknow with Breakthrough organized a Three Days Workshop cum Counselling Session on "Stand Up Against Street Harassment" from 7th to 9th October 2021 under the Mission Shakti Vishesh Abhiyan Phase-III. Mission Shakti aims at promoting the safety, respect and self-reliance of women. Keeping this in view. our event was aimed to educate youth and reinforce the idea of women empowerment.

Violence and discrimination against women and girls in India have been increasing day by day. Breakthrough is an organization with a mission to make violence and discrimination against women and girls unacceptable by building a gender sensitive adolescents and young adults. This program was designed to encourage the young minds to break the silence and intervene in any kind of harassment to create a world wherein every individual can live a life with dignity, equality and justice.

The program started with the welcome address delivered by Dr. K.M.Moeed, Principal University Polytechnic and the Convener of the event. Thereafter, Prof. (Dr.) Iffat Zareen Ahmad, Chairperson, Women Grievance Cell, Integral University and the Co-convener of the event, shared her views on several issues in context to women security and dignity. Further, the External Experts Miss Neha Mishra and Mr. Shantanu Vashisth, the Trainers from Breakthrough, carried the program forward by interacting with the students and faculty members and motivated them to share their personal experiences. They briefed the students about what harassment looks like and how to respond if one gets harassed. They also trained the students to effectively and safely respond when they witness or experience street/workplace/open place harassment.

It was a 3-days workshop cum counselling session organised to build awareness and intervention strategy among our students/ team members/ colleagues which ultimately would lead to a safe campus for women and girls. The program witnessed around 290 registrations including both students and faculty members. All the participants who attended the session, were provided with E-certificates from Breakthrough.

The event was a huge success, under the valuable guidance and support of Prof. (Dr.) Monowar Alam Khalid, Dean Students' Welfare, Integral University. The 3 days sessions were effectively moderated by Mrs. Asra Khan, Lecturer in English, University Polytechnic. The program was very well coordinated and
