

A report on 2nd National Pharmacovigilance Week (From 17th - 23rd September, 2022)

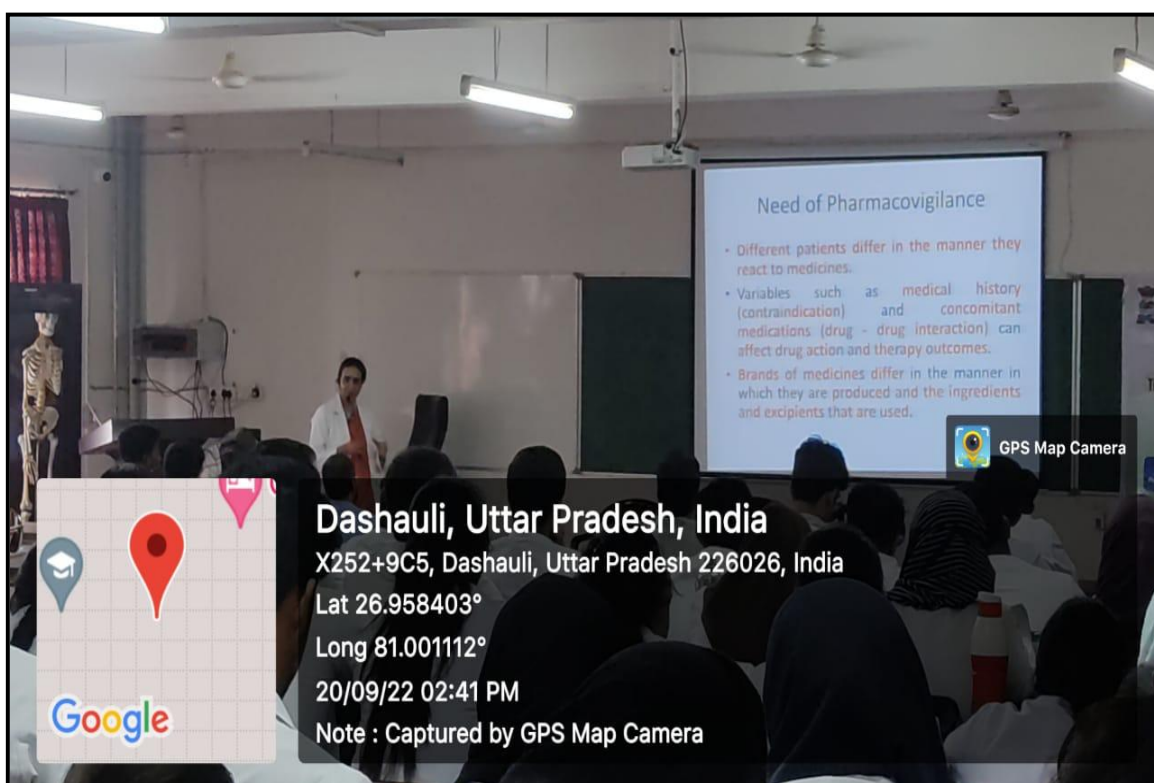
