- 3. Any changes of this Memorandum are to be done in a written form and signed by both Parties.

- 4. Realization of concrete principles of the agreement shall be carried out on mutual understanding and consent.
- 5. This Memorandum comes to effect for a period of 5 years unless terminated earlier by either higher school and comes into effect from the moment of signing it.
- 6. This Memorandum is made in two copies (English). Both Parties receive copies of equal legal power.
