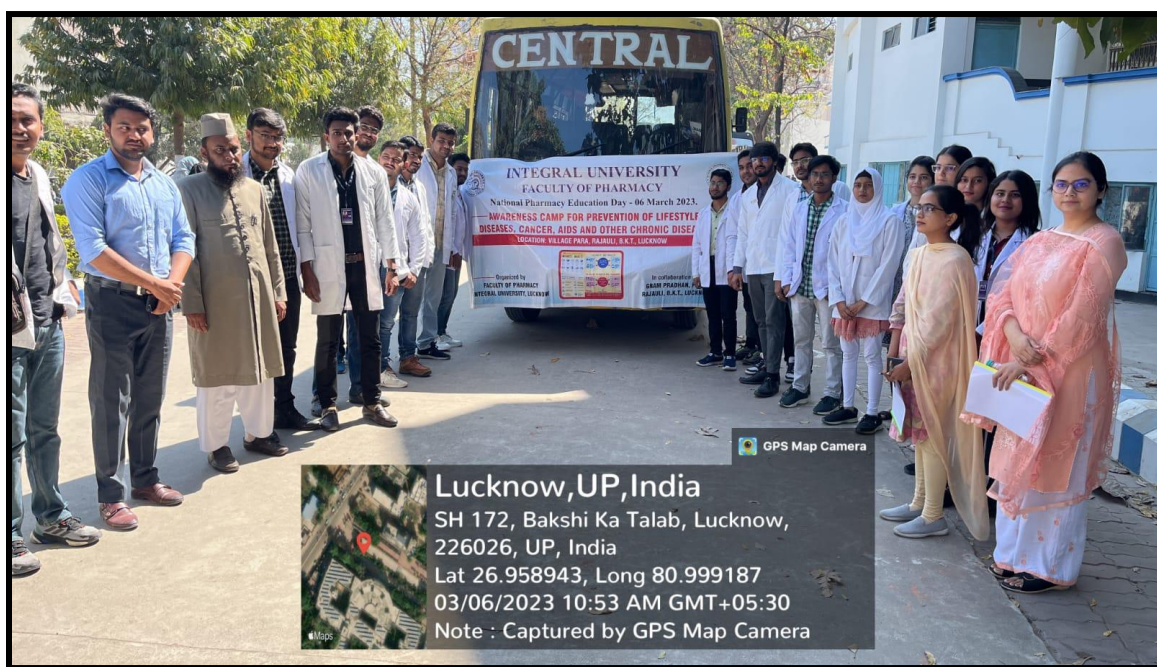
Awareness Campaigns

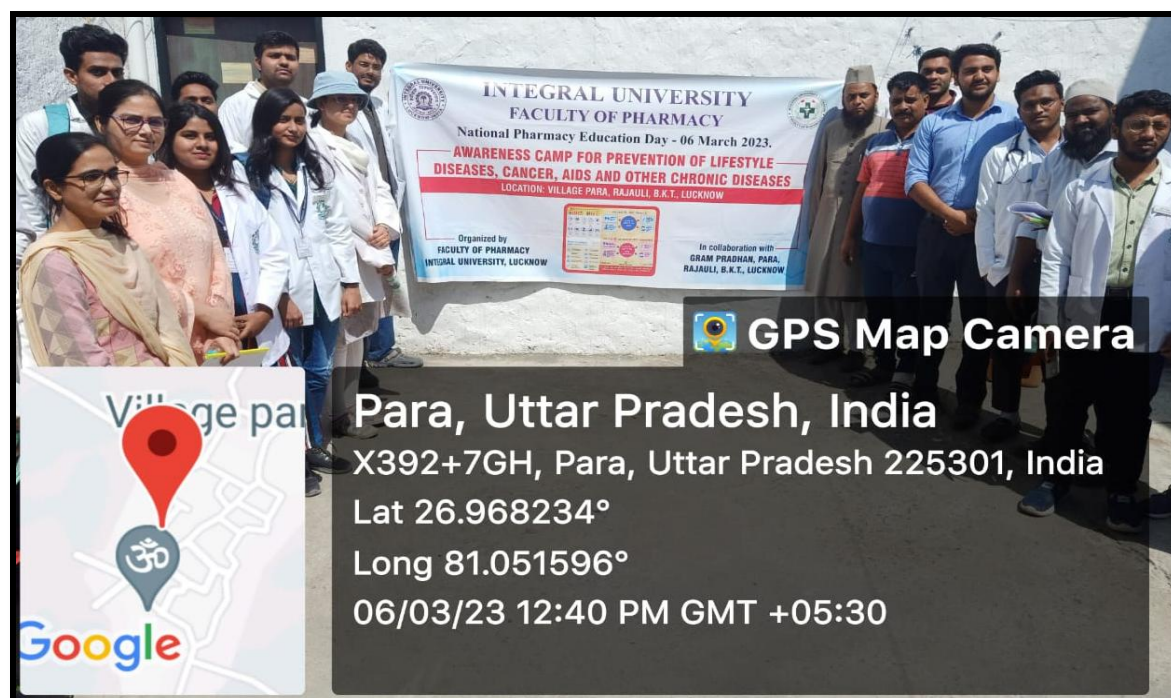

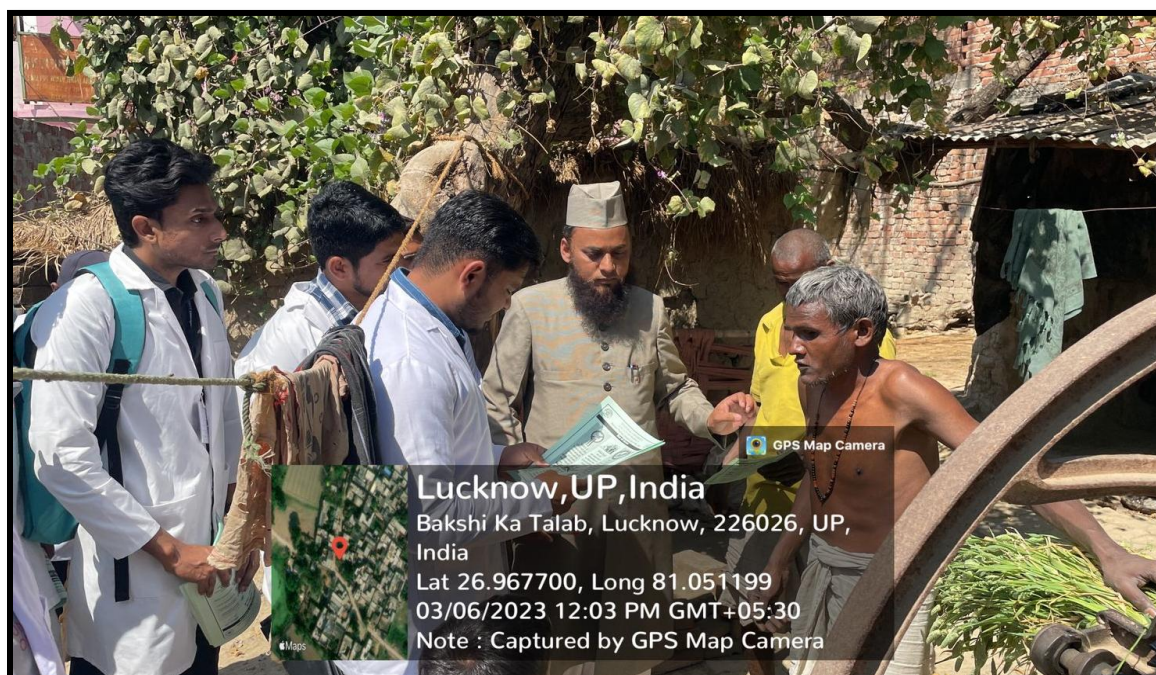

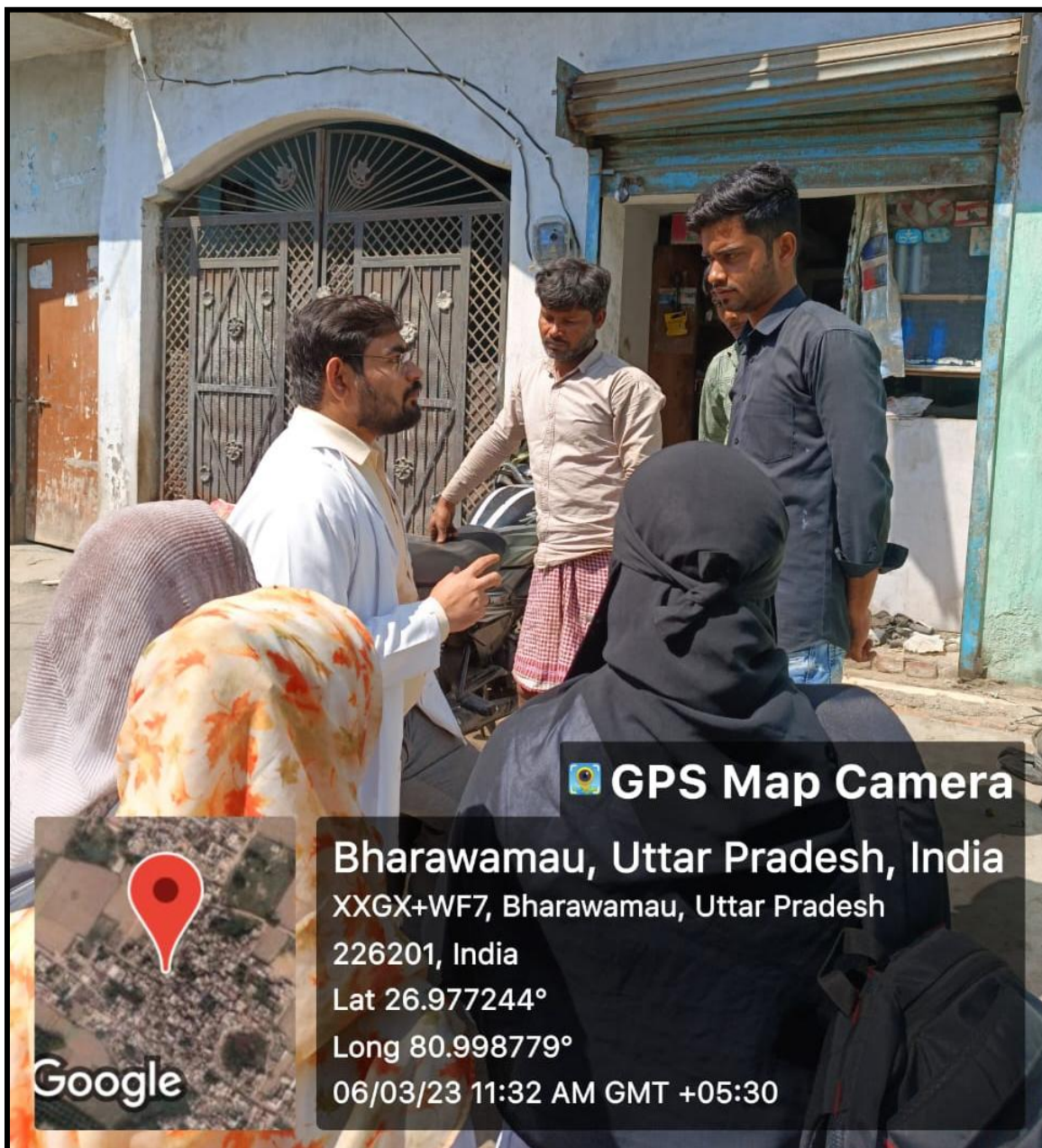

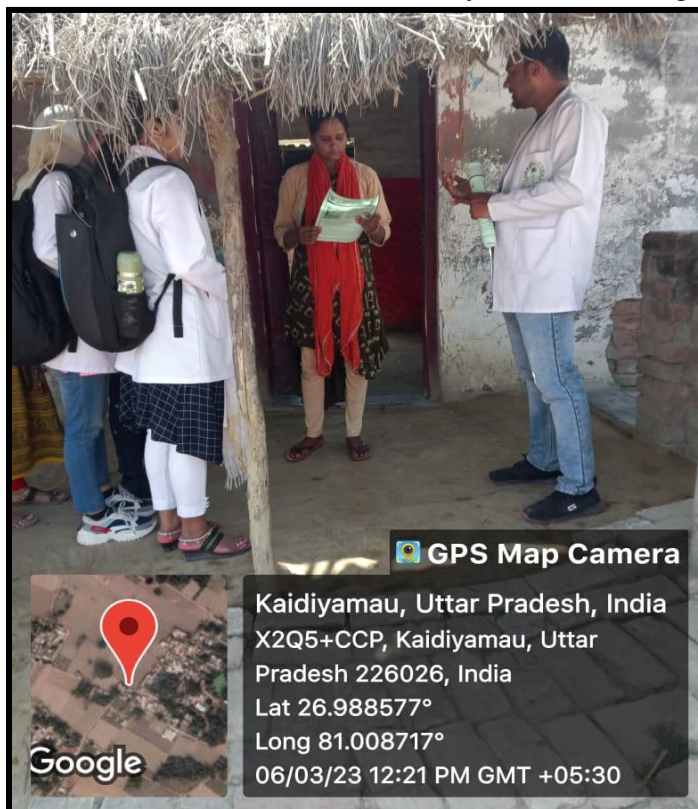
