The Department of Chemistry, Integral University organized a guest lecture on "Environmental sustainability: Current scenario, Challenges and Way ahead" by Dr. Naveen Kumar Arora, Professor, B.R. Ambedkar University on September 13th in NLT-5 at noon for the students of the faculty of science. The lecture was conceptualized to conserve natural resources and protect global ecosystems to support health and wellbeing, now and in the future. The activity was further aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 13 and 15. SDG 13 emphasizes taking urgent actions to combat climate change and associated adverse effects to save lives and livelihood, whereas SDG 15 encompasses the protection and restoration of terrestrial ecosystems and sustainable management of forests. To sustain the beauty and natural function of the environment, humankind must first take drastic steps toward environmental sustainability and avoids actions that harm or deplete it. The speaker engaged the audience by sharing interesting anecdotes and experiences and he emphasized the importance of individual roles and responsibility towards environmental protection. The program concluded on a note that the practice of environmental sustainability helps to ensure that the needs of today's population are met without jeopardizing the ability of future generations to meet their needs.
