The event was organized in hybrid mode on October 12, 2023, from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM in Hall No. 2 of the Central Auditorium, Integral University. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Eram Aziz, an esteemed Assistant Professor at Manav Rachna University, Faridabad, Haryana. The coordinators of this event were Dr. Manisha Singh and Dr. Bushra Sumaiya from Faculty of Education, Integral University, Lucknow.

The welcome note and introduction of the speaker was given by Dr. Bushra Sumaiya.

Dr. Eram Aziz, the resource person for this lecture, is a distinguished educator with an extensive background in education and a wealth of experience. She holds a Ph.D. in Education, M.Sc. in Biosciences, M.Ed., and UGC-NET qualifications. Dr. Aziz has been a teacher educator for 13 years and has made significant contributions to the field. Her expertise includes work on the TPACK framework and ICT-enabled pedagogies, along with numerous publications in reputable national and international journals. She has also served as a resource person for the CBSE Centre for Excellence and NIOS, highlighting her significant contributions to education.

Dr. Eram Aziz’s lecture focused on innovative pedagogies in the teaching-learning process. The presentation covered a range of topics, including the concept of pedagogy, the difference between traditional and innovative pedagogies, and the importance of collaborative learning, problem-based learning, case studies, peer teaching, team teaching, outdoor learning, experiential-based learning, and project-based learning. These methods were explored as effective tools for improving the teaching-learning experience and enhancing student engagement and understanding. Following were the key takeaways from this insightful lecture:

Understanding Pedagogy: The lecture emphasized the role of pedagogy as the method of teaching, which includes the educator’s understanding of how students learn. Pedagogy shapes classroom interactions and is crucial for accommodating different learning styles.

Traditional Vs. Innovative Pedagogies: The lecture highlighted the shift from traditional, teacher-centered approaches to innovative pedagogies that promote active, learner-centered experiences, offering students more control over their learning.

Collaborative Learning: Collaborative learning was introduced as a powerful approach where students actively engage, exchange ideas, and collaborate within groups. This method fosters active learning, increased learner engagement, and the development of critical thinking skills.

Problem-Based Learning: Problem-based learning, which involves students addressing real-world issues and proposing solutions, was presented as a practical way to mimic the work of scholars and prepare students for problem-solving in their future endeavors.

Case Studies, Peer Teaching, and Team Teaching: These methods were discussed as effective ways to engage students and expose them to various perspectives and content knowledge, promoting a richer learning experience.

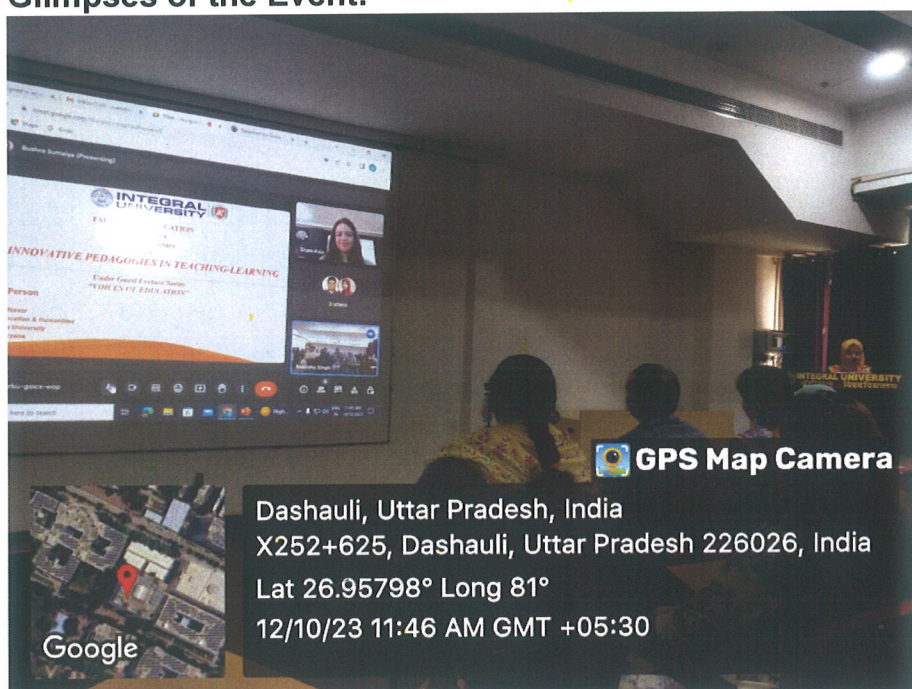

Project-Based Learning: This approach was introduced as a means for students to work on long-term projects that apply their knowledge and skills to solve real-world problems.

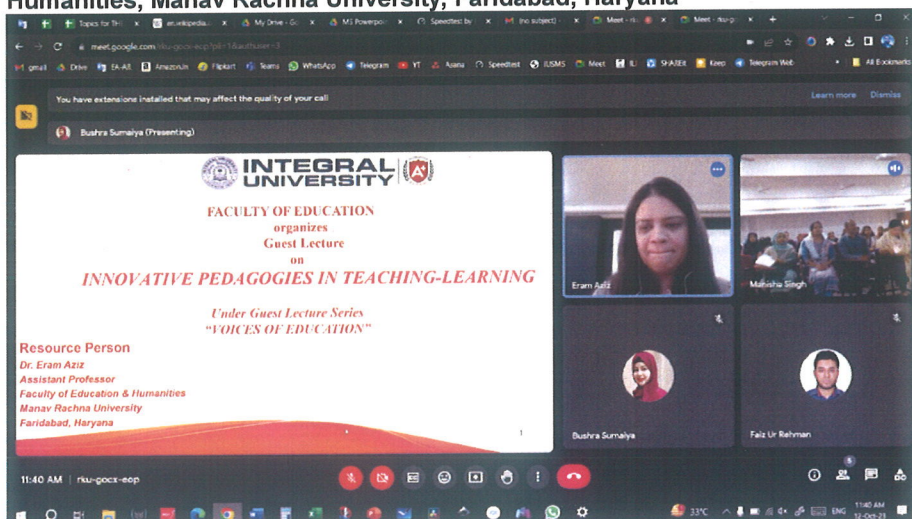

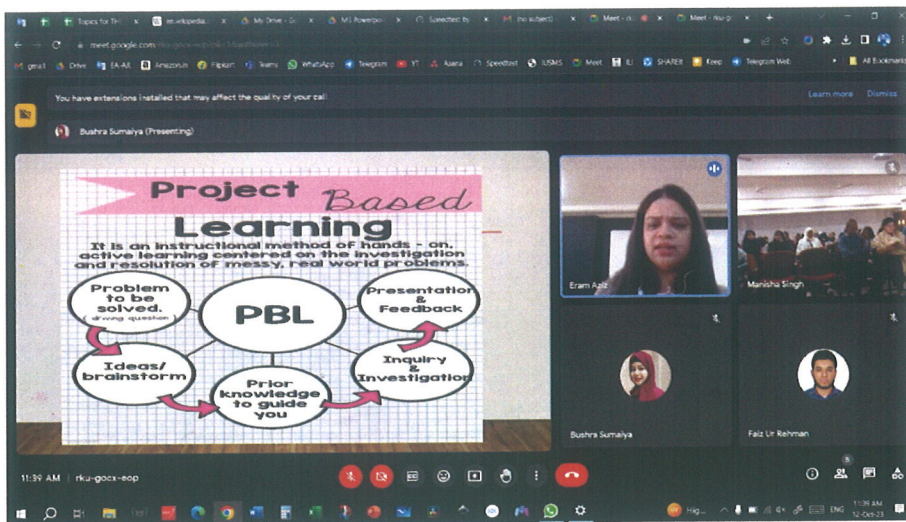
