

Terminology Familiarization: Providing a comprehensive understanding of relevant terminology used in the field of intellectual property, ensuring that participants can navigate discussions and legal aspects related to IPR more effectively.

Role of NIPAM: Shedding light on the National IP Awareness Mission's role in promoting awareness and understanding of intellectual property rights at a national level.
