The head of the department **Prof. S.S. Mazhar** spoke about the importance of the session for the staff and the students.

The Seminar on Case Study Pedagogy, offered an in-depth exploration of the educational technique known as case study pedagogy, emphasizing its benefits, implementation strategies, and practical applications across various fields. The seminar commenced with an introduction to the history and evolution of case studies in education, highlighting their origins in law and business schools and their gradual adoption in other disciplines. Keynote speakers elaborated on how case studies facilitate active learning by engaging students in real-world scenarios that require critical thinking, problem-solving, and decision-making. By analyzing detailed narratives of actual events or hypothetical situations, students can apply theoretical knowledge to practical situations, thereby enhancing their understanding and retention of course material. The seminar underscored the importance of designing effective case studies, stressing the need for cases to be relevant, challenging, and aligned with learning objectives. Presenters shared best practices for crafting compelling case narratives, including the integration of multimedia elements to enrich the learning experience.






