Department of Mechanical Engineering, in collaboration with the NSS unit of Integral University, Lucknow, organized an extension activity entitled "Labour Laws and Eradication of Child Labour" in alignment with Sustainable Development Goal 8 (SDG-8).

This initiative was aimed to raise awareness about the importance of SDG-8, focusing on the significance of Labour Laws and the eradication of child labour. The objective of this effort was to create a positive environment for establishing robust social protection systems, creating opportunities for decent work, and ensuring sustainable livelihoods, especially for marginalized and vulnerable groups. Notably, SDG 8, Target 8.7, aims to "take immediate and effective measures to eradicate forced labour and secure the prohibition and elimination of all forms of child labour."

The activity occurred on May 11, 2024, at "Labour Adda," Pahadpur Chauraha, Gudamba, Lucknow. Students and a few staff members of the Department of Mechanical Engineering were present and engaged with the labourers, discussing opportunities for decent work and sustainable livelihoods. They highlighted the importance of skill development for obtaining better jobs and higher wages, and explained various government initiatives aimed at supporting entrepreneurship and enhancing employability.

Dr. Moh. Seraj from the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Integral University, Lucknow highlighted the evils of child labour, explaining how it deprives children of their childhood, education, and health, thereby perpetuating poverty and undermining economic and social development. By striving to end child labour, countries can promote decent work and sustainable livelihoods, fostering more equitable and inclusive societies.

The event concluded with a pledge to contribute towards eradicating poverty and child labour from society. The activity saw the participation of twenty-six students from the Department of Mechanical Engineering and forty labourers. Mr. Khalid Siddiqui, a senior instructor from the Department, accompanied the students and arranged transportation for them.

Dr. P.K. Bharti, Dr. Faiz Mohd, Dr. Moh. Seraj and Mr Naeem Akhtar took the initiative and played key roles in ensuring the smooth execution of the above extension activity.
