The online format of the quiz allowed for convenient participation and enabled students to join from different locations. The participation representation is shown in the graph below.

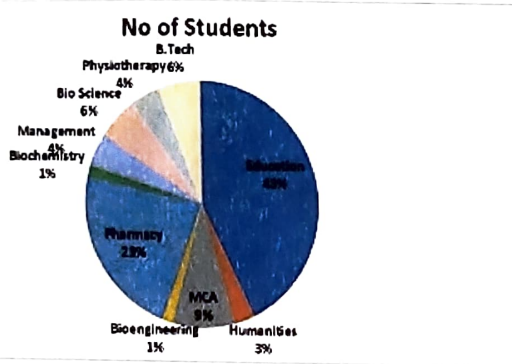
Outcome:
