Students' support is a substantial part of any teaching-learning process. Mock interviews help candidates to reduce their stress and anxiety about interviewing. Keeping this in mind, the Faculty of Education organized a Mock Interview on 10 May 2024 at W-403,IV floor, Academic Block W, Phase-II. Integral University Lucknow. This interview was to prepare the final year students of B.Ed., M.Ed. and D.El.Ed. programs to face future interviews and have an idea related to the questions asked.

## Highlights of the Event:

Program started with the welcome address of Prof.(Dr.) A.K. Lodi, Head, Department of Education. In his welcome address, the Head of the Department sensitized the students about the role of teachers in society and said that teachers are the pillars of society. Therefore, all the work done by them affects the future of the students, keeping this in mind all the pupil teachers should prepare themselves to be good teachers. After that Mr. Rasid Khan, Principal, Integral International School, Sansarpur, Lucknow interacted with the pupil teachers and boosted their confidence. He shared his personal experiences and calmed the students for their interview. He described the duty and accountability of teachers and narrated a short story portraying the characteristics of a teacher which was well received by the students.

Once the interview started, various questions were asked to the students one by one. The weaknesses, as well as the strengths of the students, were told by the panel. There were various suggestions regarding Curriculum Vitae and expected behaviour during the interview provided by the panel members. Total Thirty -Three final year pupil teachers got registered for Mock-Interview from M.Ed., B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. Programs.

In the concluding remarks Dr.Aareena Nazneen, Assistant Professor, Department of Languages, Integral University, Lucknow told the pupil teachers about the precautions to be taken during the interview and said that it is necessary to pay attention to the body language in front of the panel as it shows the state of confidence. Apart from this, she said that the in-depth knowledge of the subject makes it easier for the students to answer. Communication skills and subject knowledge are two parameters that should be specially taken care of in the interview.

During the feedback session, Prof.(Dr.) A. K. Lodi explained how good Curriculum Vitae plays an important role in any interview and marked the do's and don'ts for the students. Pupil teachers shared their feedback too. Dr.Eklak Ahmad one of the Panel members for Mock-Interview emphasized punctuality and communication skills. Further he added that the pupil teaches that the real beauty of and of E

teacher lies in the way he behaves towards the students. He said that practice is such a weapon that cuts the biggest obstacles, so the teacher should always motivate his students to keep practicing. This inculcates the habit of working hard which gives them a bright future. He also gave best wishes to each student teacher for their interview.

Overall Mock-Interview was successful and pupil teachers got a lot of insight as to how they have to prepare themselves to face future job interviews. Faculty coordinator for this event was Dr. Smita Srivastava, Faculty of Education.
