

A Brief Report on Deeksharambh- Student Induction Programme held from 1 to 3 August 2024

It is a matter of great pleasure that the Department of Languages successfully organized the Orientation/Induction Programme from 1 to 3 August 2024 for the newly admitted undergraduate and postgraduate students. The orientation programme was held in different sessions in which 15 students were present out of total 26 students.
