

A brief report of extension activity on “Right to Vote and E-voting” in collaboration with NSS at Vill- Chetanpurwa, Post- Bas-ha, Kursi Road, Lucknow held on 30th April 2024 organized by the Department of Civil Engineering, Integral University, Lucknow.

The department of Civil Engineering in collaboration with National Service Scheme has organized an awareness program on “**Right to Vote and E-voting**” in a village Chetan Purwa, Post Basha, Kursi Road, Lucknow on **30th April 2024**. The objective of this extension activity was to educate

citizens about their right to vote, the significance of voting in a democratic system, and the benefits and processes of E-Voting (electronic voting), particularly in fostering an efficient, accessible, and transparent voting system. To increase the participation and voting percentage in the election, 65 students with faculty and staff have visited in the Chetan



Purwa village and discuss with the People of age 18 years and above through door-to-door campaign. participants learned about the history of voting rights and the role of elections in shaping governance. The program highlighted the responsibilities of citizens in upholding democracy and



ensuring their voices heard through voting. The event fostered a sense of civic responsibility and empowerment among attendees, motivating them to become advocates for voter education and engagement in their communities. The program concluded with a pledge to uphold the principles of democracy and actively participate in the democratic

process through responsible voting.
