The Social Responsibility Club of the Computer Science Engineering Department, in collaboration with the NGO "PYS Foundation", embarked on a noble endeavor to alleviate the plight of the underprivileged through a Cloth Distribution Drive. This initiative aimed to provide essential clothing to those in need, particularly as winter approached.

To ensure widespread participation and support, the Winter Clothing Drive was extensively promoted within the university campus community. Information about the drive was disseminated through various social media platforms and posters distributed across the department and university campus. This proactive approach helped garner significant attention and support for the cause.

From **December 1<sup>st</sup> to 31, 2023,** collection bins were strategically placed at various locations within the campus to facilitate the donation process. The response from stakeholders across the university was overwhelming, with a generous outpouring of donated clothes. Subsequently, volunteers diligently sorted the donated clothes by age-group and season, ensuring that recipients would receive appropriate apparel tailored to their needs.

The culmination of the donation drive saw the distribution of clothes on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2024, in the Munshipuliya area and its vicinity. Clothes were distributed to more than 75 people belonging to marginalized segments of society, including orphans, widows, the elderly, and individuals residing in orphanages, slums, and asylums. This targeted approach ensured that the donated clothes reached those who needed them the most, providing warmth and comfort during the harsh winter months.
