The **Department of Environmental Science** under the aegis of **Eco-Sync (Environmental Club)** of **Integral University, Lucknow** hosted an **Online Quiz Competition** In lieu of **International Electronic Waste Day** on **3rd November 2024** for students from different disciplines of the University. International E-Waste Day is a global event that raises awareness of the electronic waste crisis and the need for responsible e-waste management.

The day is celebrated on October 14th each year and was first introduced in 2018 by the Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Forum. This year's theme was **"Join the e-waste hunt - retrieve, recycle, and revive!"** which focused on the forgotten electronics that people have in their homes, but which contain valuable materials that could gain a new life. This event aims to provide a powerful understanding among students to become environmentally aware of electronic waste and actively engage in sustainable practices. It was a great opportunity to test knowledge, learn more about e-waste and promote sustainability. By engaging participants through an online assessment format, the department sought to promote sustainable practices related to e-waste management.

The quiz attracted a diverse audience, including students from B.Tech, BALLB, MCA, D Pharma, BBA, MSc, BCA, BHM, BPT, BSc, BA and research scholars. A **total number of 113 students** got registered for the quiz. The quiz duration was of 40 minutes with 30 multiple-choice questions covering topics such as e-waste statistics, recycling processes and environmental consequences of improper disposal. The quiz was designed to challenge the participants' knowledge, quick thinking, and problem-solving abilities. Following are the results of position holders for the competition:
