National Girl Child Day 24th January, 2025

Venue: Village Sansarpur, B.K.T. Lucknow

Community service is a cornerstone of a thriving society, fostering a sense of shared responsibility and interconnectedness among its members. By actively engaging in activities that benefit the community, individuals not only contribute to the well-being of others but also gain invaluable personal and social growth. Community service cultivates empathy, compassion, and a deeper understanding of societal needs, while simultaneously promoting civic engagement and building stronger and more resilient communities. It bridges gaps between different segments of society, fosters a sense of belonging, and creates a more equitable and just world for all.

With this objective, an Extension Activity in the form of a Community Service was organized by the Faculty of Education, Integral University Lucknow on 24th January 2025 in village Sansarpur, B.K.T. Lucknow to celebrate the National Girl Child Day. The activity witnessed enthusiastic participation of 78 students of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. programs. The theme of the program was "Gender Equality and Women Empowerment" which aimed to raise awareness about gender inequality and bias towards girls and women, as well as the significance of education, nutrition, legal rights, medical care, and safety. The design of the event aligned with SDG Goal 5- "Achieve Gender Equality and empower all women and girls"- and the United Nations Academic Impact.

Before departing to the venue of the event, Prof. (Dr.) A. K. Lodi, Dean, Faculty of Education, addressed students and briefed about community service. Students were also told

about how their active participation engages them with the community, creates special bonds with the population being served, and increases social awareness and responsibility. Dr. Ekhlak Ahmad, Head, Department of Education, gave the required instructions to the students and motivated them to participate enthusiastically in the event.

The team of students and faculty coordinators met the Gram Pradhan of village Sansarpur, Dr Anil Kumar Yadav, after which the program began. The students showed their gratitude towards the village by presenting a sapling to him. The students planned various activities like song, speech, poem, Nukkad Natak, skits, etc. which emphasized on creating awareness about gender equality, women empowerment, women education, women rights and other related issues.

The activities started with a rally throughout the village with posters and slogans related to the theme. After completion of the rally, all the students, faculty members and people of village gathered at a ground for other activities to be performed.

The program started under the guidance of Dr. Noorain Anas, Assistant Professor Faculty of Education. Anchor of the program was Noorah Idris, a student of B.Ed. IV semester. A welcome song was sung by Jaya Sarkar, a student of B.Ed. IV semester and member of Gender Champions Club. The program proceeded with speeches on various themes that were delivered by the students of B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. second year- on Gender Equality by Farheen Mirza, on National Girl Child Day by Inza Alam, on Women Education by Ayushi Swarnkar, and on Women Empowerment by Shaista Khan. A poem was recited by Umme Hilal, a student of B.Ed. II Semester.

The rally reached the government primary school of village Sansarpur where the students of B.Ed. II Semester- Shaifali Pawar, Roshni Kumari, Pragati Maurya, Pooja Yadav, Ashish Kumar, Maaz Abdul Mannan, Shifa Alam and Rehnuma Ansari performed a skit on Women Empowerment through Education and Gender Equality. It was followed by a poster presentation by the students of D.El.Ed. II Semester.

Ms. Madhuri Mishra, Principal, Govt. Primary School, Village Sansarpur expressed a motivational speech focusing on various career opportunities for the students of teacher training programmes. She also emphasised on women education and empowerment. Nodal Teacher Gender Champions Dr. Vivek Rogers Assistant Professor, Faculty of Education

concluded the program and gave vote of thanks to the Panchayat people and school staff for their active participation and cooperation.










