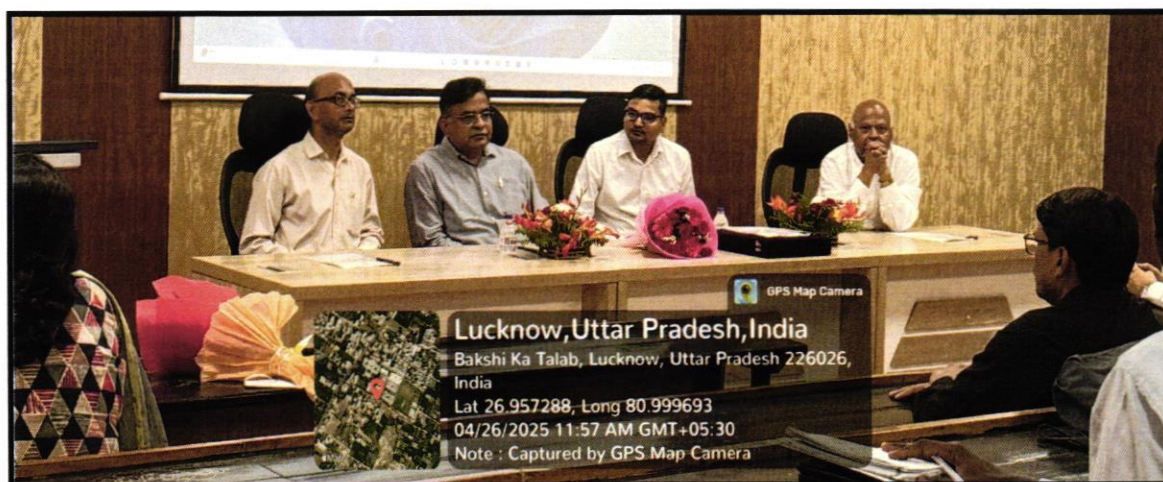

It featured expert talks, interactive sessions, and real-world insights into patent filing, innovation management, and legal frameworks related to IPR.

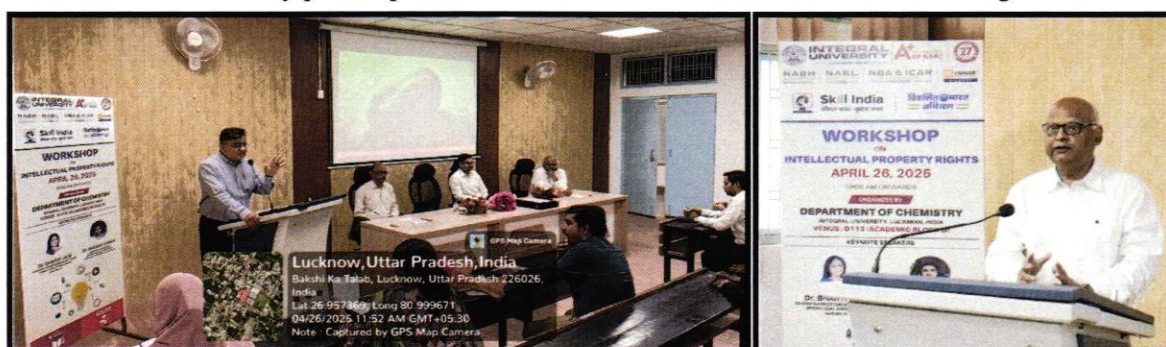

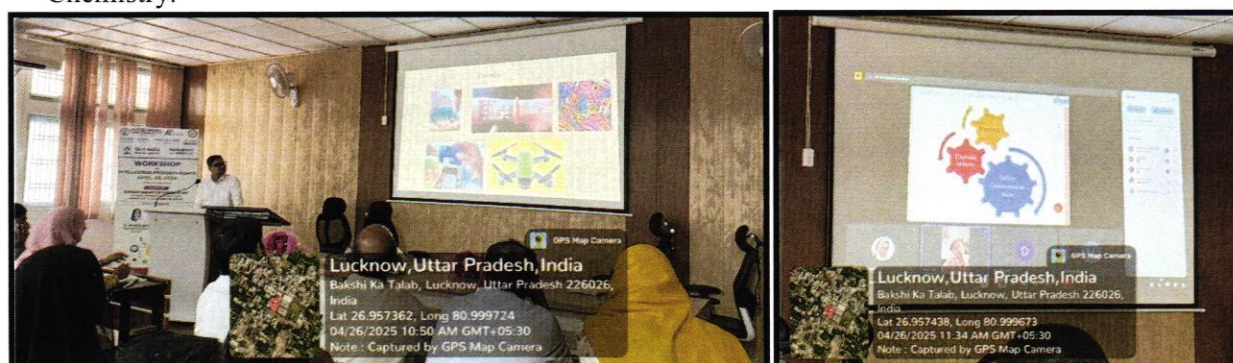

In his address **Prof. Wahajul Haq**, highlighted the role of innovation and patents in advancing research. He encouraged researchers to think beyond traditional boundaries and actively pursue patentable solutions that address real-world challenges.

Dr. Kumar also shared real-world examples of successful patents emerging from university research, inspiring participants to explore the commercial potential of their own work. **Dr. Bharati Jain** in her online session offered a legal perspective on IPR and detailed the patent filing process. She elaborated on the key stages involved in securing a patent, common challenges faced during filing, and the importance of legal compliance in protecting innovations. Her session provided participants with practical knowledge essential for navigating the complexities of intellectual property law. The speakers were introduced to audience by **Dr. Tahmeena Khan**, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry.

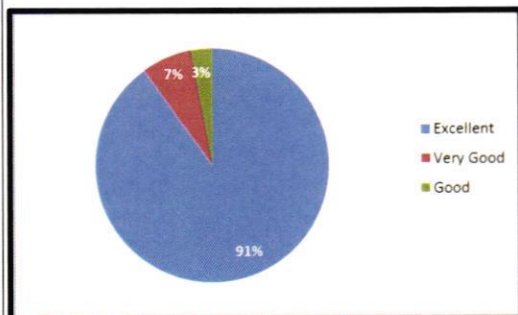

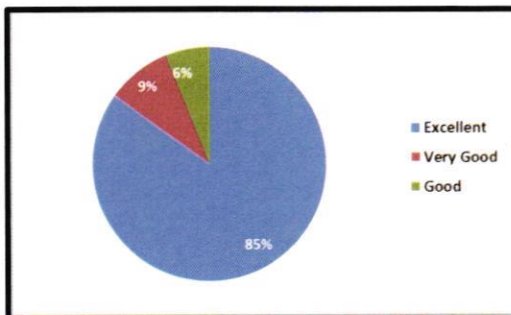

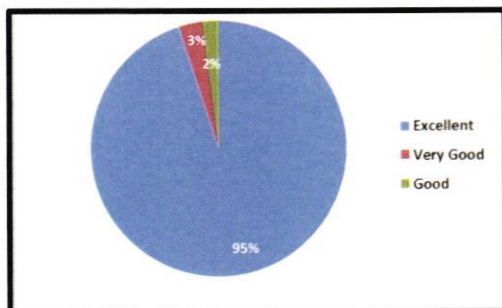
**Q1. How would you rate your overall experience at the IPR workshop?**
