Integral University, Lucknow**

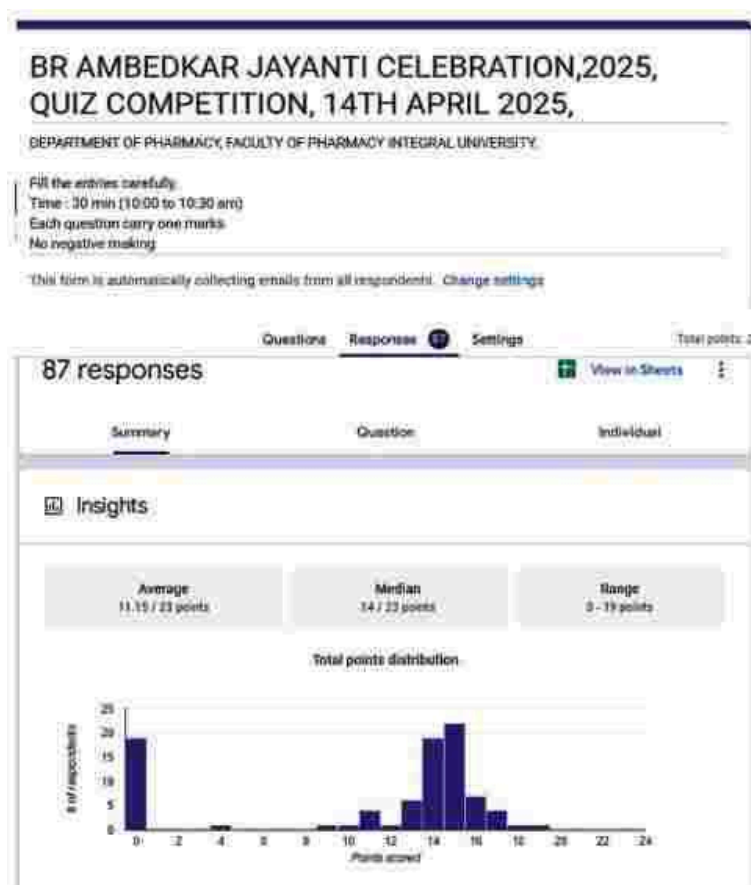
