

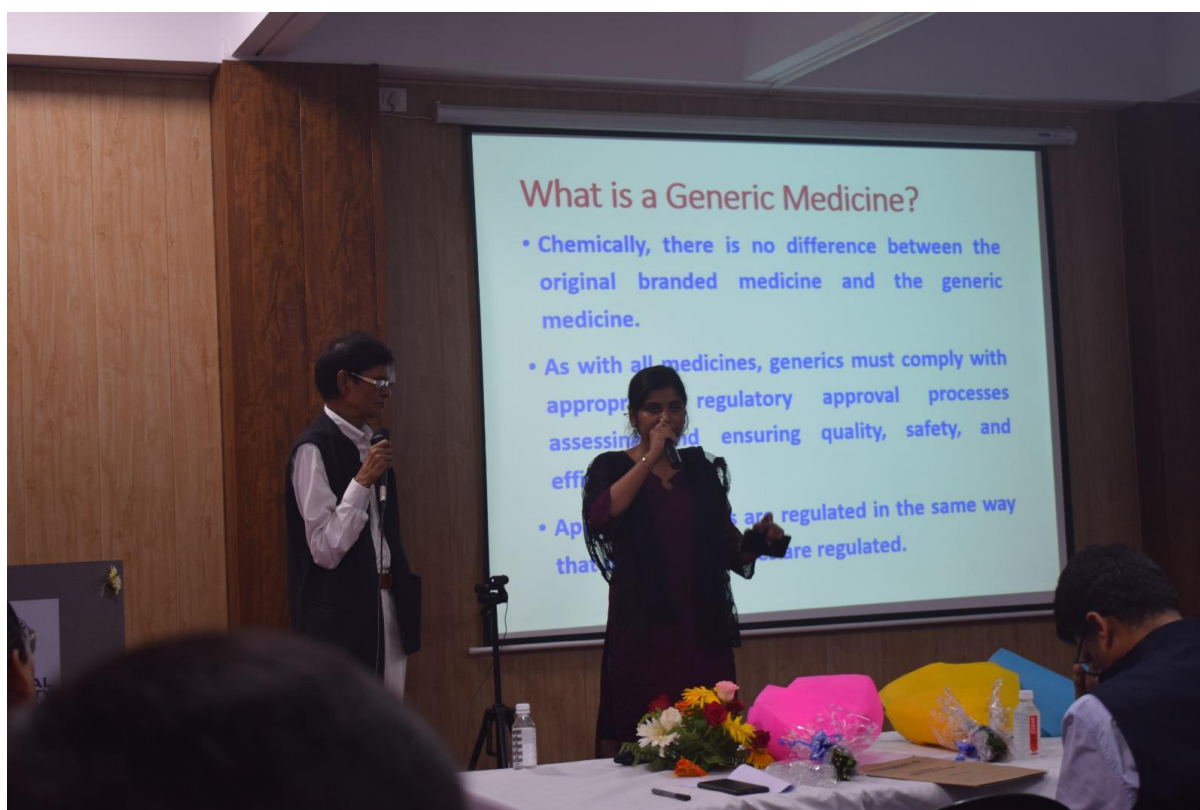
Faculty of Pharmacy Celebrated World Pharmacists Day 2024: A Celebration of Pharmacists' Role in Global Health

Welcome address by Prof. (Dr.) Syed Misbahul Hasan, Dean, Faculty of Pharmacy


