


Figure 1. REGARDING ONLINE QUIZ




Figure 2. REGARDING RESPONSES ON QUIZ





Figure 3. REGARDING ONLINE QUIZ ON QUESTIONS ON MISSION SHAKTI





Figure 4. REGARDING SSAY WRITING ON MISSION SHAKTI








Figure 5. REGARDING SLOGAN COMPETITION ON MISSION SHAKTI
