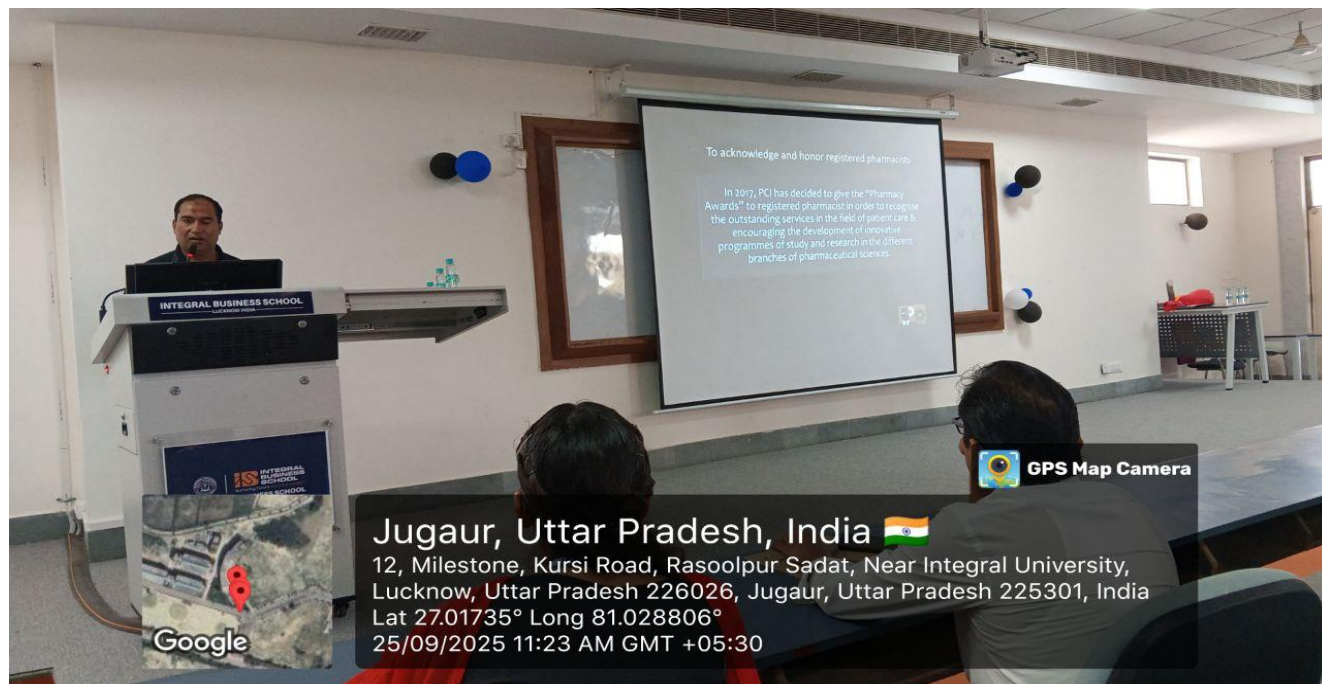


Figure 2: Address by Dr. Mohd Arif

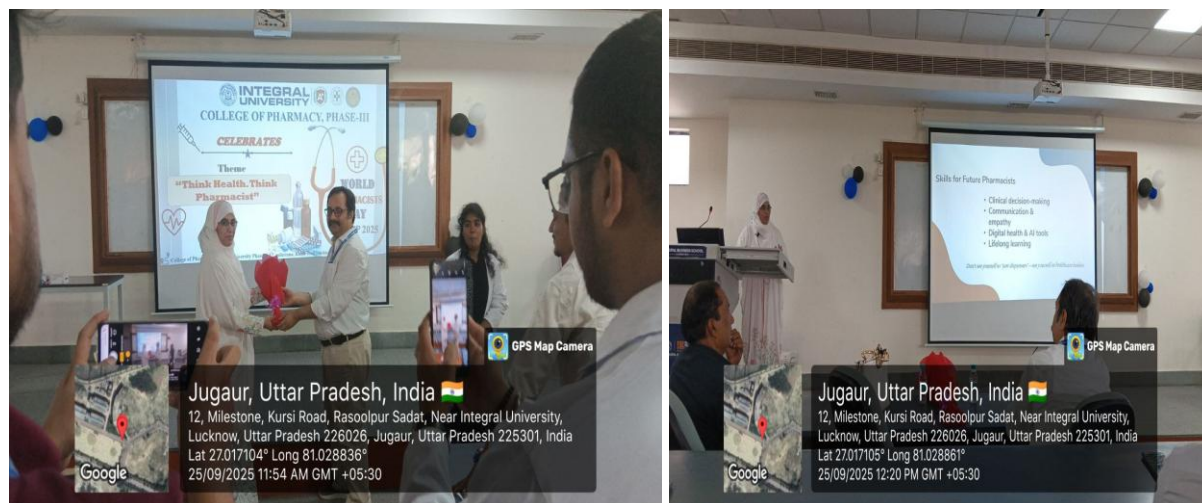


Figure 3 : Guest lecture by Dr. Ambreen Shoaib

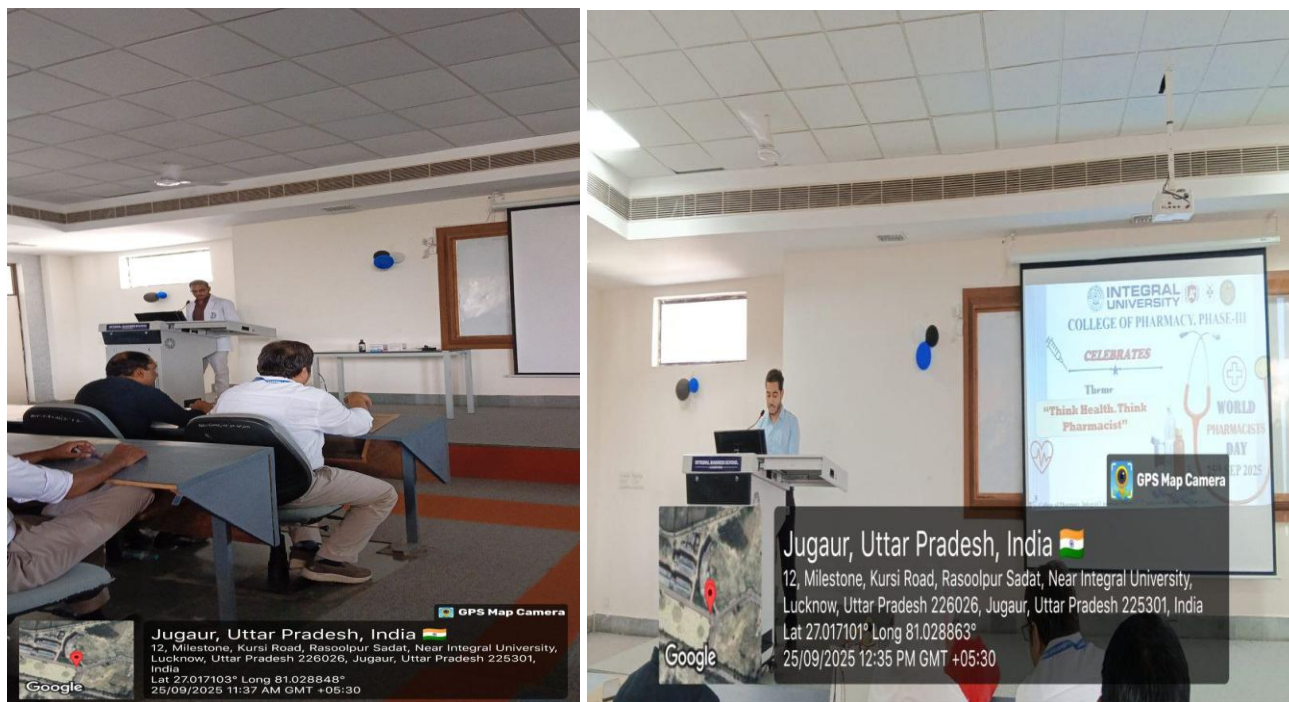


Figure 4 : Speech by students

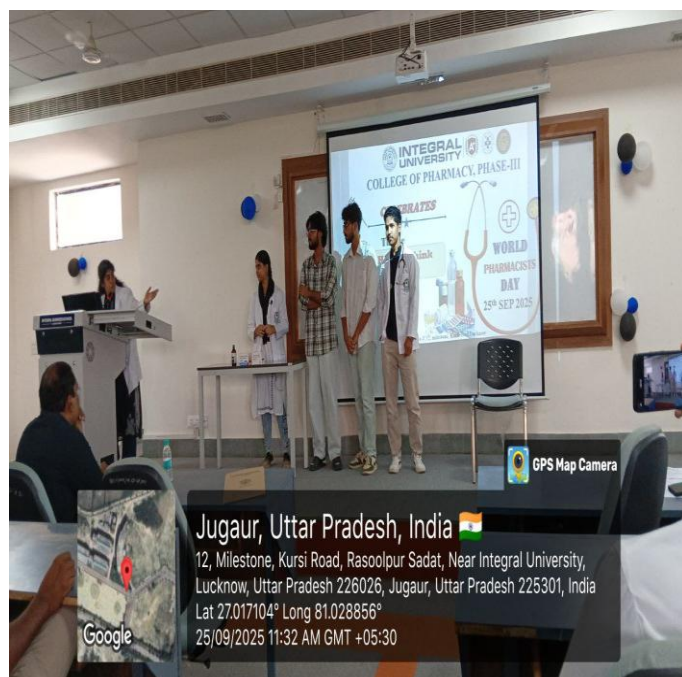


Figure 6: Skit competition

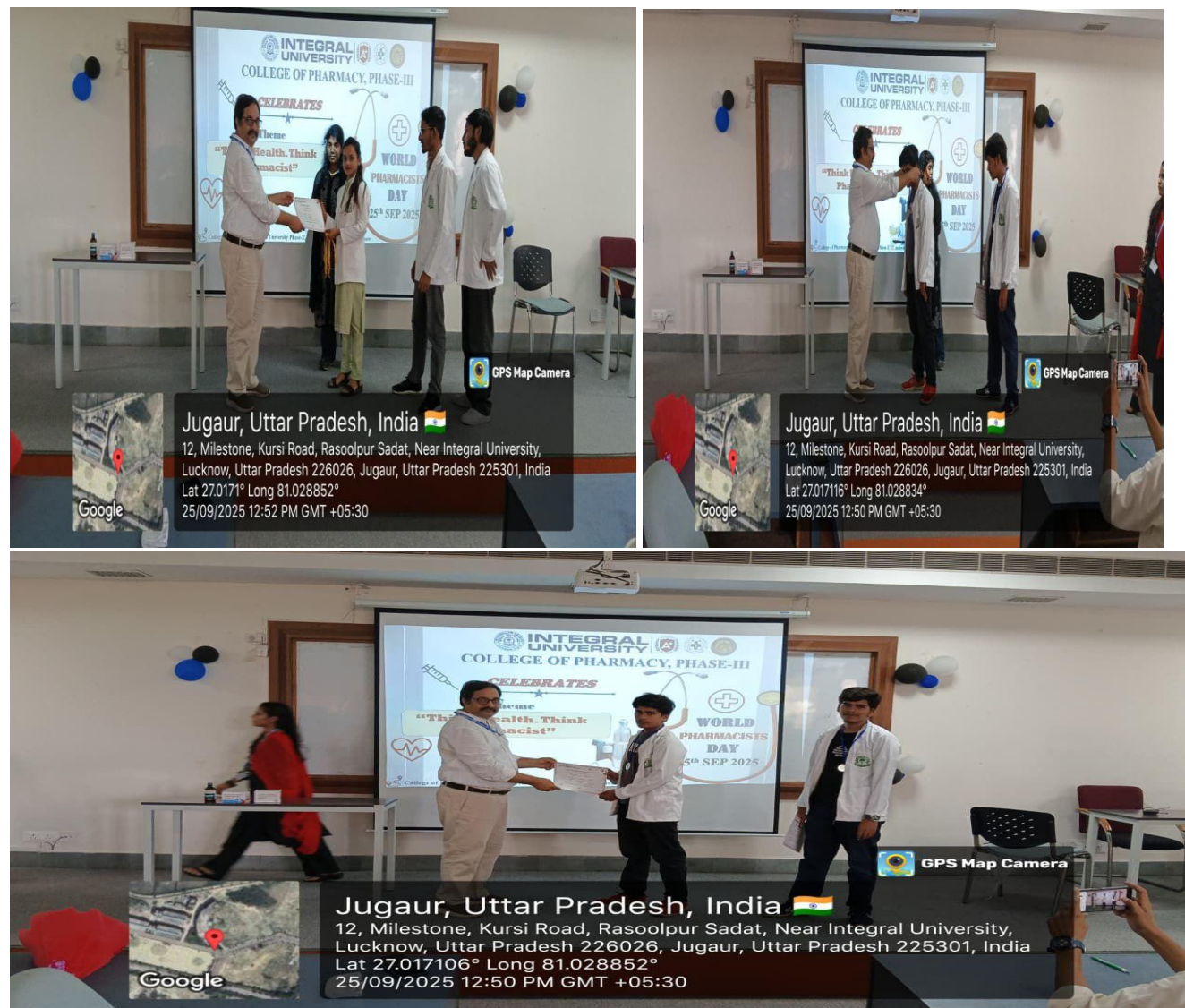


Figure 8 : Certificate and medal distribution.
