In compliance with the directive from **The Higher Education Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh, the Department of Languages** successfully organized a series of commemorative events to mark the **100th anniversary of the historic Kakori Train Action** executed by the Hindustan Republican Association on August 9, 1925. The celebrations honored the revolutionary spirit of Ram Prasad Bismil, Ashfaqulla Khan, Rajendra Lahiri, Chandrashekhar Azad, and their fellow freedom fighters under the distinguished leadership of **Prof. H.M. Arif, Head of Languages**.

EVENTS OVERVIEW

The department conducted multiple events from August 8-12, 2025, creating a comprehensive celebration that merged historical remembrance with contemporary values of environmental consciousness, scholarly expression, and community engagement. These events successfully brought history alive through the active participation of students from various departments including English, BCA, BTech, BBA LLB, DSAI, and BA programs.

ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from students who showcased deep insight, research, and creativity in their essays on the theme *"Remembering Kakori: How the 1925 Train Action Ignited the Flames of Independence."* The entries were judged based on originality, historical accuracy, coherence, and relevance, with participants drawing meaningful parallels between the spirit of 1925 and present-day patriotism. **Saanhvi Srivastava (BBA LLB IInd Year) secured first position, followed by Eshal Ali (DSAI A Ist Year) in second place and Tayyaba Haseen Hashmi (B.A. II Year) in third position.** The event was coordinated by **Dr. Aareena Nazneen** and judged by **Dr. Sugandha Agnihotri and Ms. Ambreen Fatima**.

PLANTATION DRIVE AND PRABHAT PHERI

Under the theme **"Ek Ped Maa ke Naam,"** a symbolic peace lily sapling was ceremonially planted within the Department of Languages on August 12, 2025, representing the transformation from the violent revolutionary action of 1925 to today's peaceful pursuit of freedom through education and knowledge. **The Prabhat Pheri** featured a patriotic morning procession with students displaying banners of Kakori revolutionaries, placards with patriotic slogans in Hindi and English, and patriotic songs that created an atmosphere of reverence and celebration. The organizing committee comprised **Dr. Vanya Srivastava as faculty coordinator, with Ms. Nikita Verma (BA English IV Year) and Ms. Isra (MA English II Year) as student coordinators**

QUIZ COMPETITION

An elaborate quiz competition was conducted with fifty-four participants from English, BCA, and BA departments. The event included a comprehensive discussion of the Kakori Case history and its impact on

India's Freedom Struggle, focusing on questions about the case's significance in developing national unity among Indians. **Syed Mohammad Ali (BCA 1st year) secured first position, Hifza Hafeez (BA 3rd Year) claimed second place, and Shayama Khatoon achieved third position.** The competition was coordinated by **Dr. Zeba Rizvi.**

SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION

Students from English, BCA, and BTech departments participated in a digital slogan writing competition that produced thought-provoking and insightful entries. All submissions were extremely impressive, with **Sadiya Fatima (BA English, 3rd year)** securing first position for her outstanding slogan. The event was coordinated by **Dr. Arshi Khan** and included historical discussions about the Kakori Case and its consequences on India's Freedom Struggle.

The collaborative efforts of faculty members including Dr. Aareena Nazneen, Dr. Arshi Khan, Dr. Vanya Srivastava, Dr. Zeba Rizvi ensured the successful execution of all events, creating a meaningful tribute to the martyrs of India's freedom struggle.
