The Constitutional Law Society at the Faculty of Law enthusiastically celebrated the 75th National Constitution Day and its 9th Constitution Day Celebration on 23rd November 2024 through a Pledge-Taking Ceremony. The event revolved around the theme "Strengthening Democracy through Electoral and Institutional Reforms." This event marked the culmination of a series of activities organized between 15th October and 23rd November. Constitution Day, observed annually on 26th November, commemorates the adoption of the Constitution of India in 1949. The pledge-taking ceremony was held on 23rd November 2024, marking the culmination of these events and celebrating the spirit of the Constitution.

The event commenced with the arrival of the distinguished chief guest, Hon'ble Justice B.D. Naqvi (Retd.), who, along with other guests, judged the entries for the Visual Verdict Poster Competition.
