Faculty of Pharmacy, Integral University Observed**‘Anti Ragging Week (12th -18th August, 2025)**

At Integral University, Lucknow, the Faculty of Pharmacy organized an Anti-Ragging Week event that included a poster-making competition and a skit play, with strong involvement from faculty members Dr. Ahsan Ahmad Khan, Dr. Asad Ahmad, Ms. Shaban Khatoon, Dr. Aftab Ahmad, and Mr. Ranjan Kumar. The aim was to sensitise students about the physical, emotional, and legal consequences of ragging, reinforce the university’s zero-tolerance stance, and encourage peer support and responsibility.

Students from all years participated enthusiastically in both activities: the poster competition produced creative visuals and slogans focused on themes such as dignity, mental health, institutional policies, and bystander intervention; the skit play dramatically portrayed real-life scenarios of ragging, the harm it causes, and how responsible students can respond or report. Faculty guidance helped frame these messages, and the post-performance discussion enabled students to reflect, ask questions, and share perspectives.

The event aligned with **Sustainable Development Goal 3 (Good Health and Well-Being)** by addressing psychological wellbeing and the harms caused by ragging; with **SDG 4 (Quality Education)** by promoting an educational environment based on safety, respect, and inclusion; and with **SDG 16 (Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions)** by reinforcing institutional policies, justice, and rule of law, and encouraging transparent mechanisms for protection and reporting. The active participation of both faculty and students underlined that maintaining a ragging-free campus is a shared responsibility. The event was successfully coordinated by the Head of the Faculty of Pharmacy, ensuring active participation and effective communication of the department’s vision for a ragging-free campus.
