Free health check-up and awareness program was conducted at the village of Baguleha, Gram Panchayat: Sikandarpur on Friday, 3rd Oct, 2025. The Department of Pharmacy provided Pharm. D students as volunteers for activities under this public health campaign awareness where students offered their time and expertise to the community. These activities included tasks like patient counselling, medication management support, and educating the public on health and wellness.

As part of the program, free medical check-ups were conducted along with distribution of medicines. The villagers were apprised on cleanliness, safe drinking water, clean environment, food and nutrition. A special focus was given over the awareness of women and girls in all families, so that the whole family could benefit.
