Report on Gandhi Jayanti Celebration, 2025
Online Quiz Competition on “Citizen Rights and Duties”**Tagline: “Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhiman”****2nd October, 2025**

In compliance with the directives issued by the Additional Secretary, Government of Uttar Pradesh, all higher education institutions were instructed to celebrate **Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October, 2025** under the theme “**Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhiman**”. In view of this

The **Faculty of Pharmacy of Integral University** organized an **Online Quiz Competition** titled “**Citizen Rights and Duties**” to commemorate the birth anniversary of **Mahatma Gandhi** and to reflect upon his contributions towards justice, peace, and non-violence. The quiz aimed to educate students on the importance of the **Indian Constitution**, civic responsibilities, and ethical citizenship. The objective of this celebration was to promote awareness about the **Constitution of India**, emphasizing **citizens’ rights and duties**, and to pay tribute to the ideals of **Mahatma Gandhi**—truth, non-violence, equality, and social justice. The quiz questions were designed to test knowledge of **fundamental rights, fundamental duties**, and **Gandhian values** in nation-building. The celebration of **Gandhi Jayanti 2025** through the **Online Quiz Competition on “Citizen Rights and Duties”** was a meaningful initiative that combined education with civic responsibility. The event highlighted the relevance of **Mahatma Gandhi’s philosophy** in modern society and encouraged students to uphold constitutional values, contributing toward building a **peaceful and inclusive society** in line with the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 4, 10, and 16)**. This event contributed to several United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): SDG 4 – Quality Education: (Promoted constitutional literacy and civic awareness among students through an interactive learning approach.), SDG 10 – Reduced Inequalities: (Reinforced the principles of equality and justice, aligning with the idea of equal rights for all citizens.) and SDG 16 – Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions: (Encouraged understanding of the rule of law, peace, and responsible citizenship, fostering respect for national values)

A total of **121 students** from various pharmacy courses enthusiastically participated in the competition. Participants gained insights into constitutional duties and citizens’ responsibilities. The event successfully reinforced Gandhian values of **non-violence, integrity, and self-reliance**. The initiative fostered a sense of **patriotism, civic engagement, and responsibility** among students. Responses given by students were checked and result was declared without any bias. E-certificates were awarded to all winners.
