The event concluded with a group photograph, capturing the smiling faces of faculty members, judges, and students who together created an atmosphere of cultural enrichment and joy.

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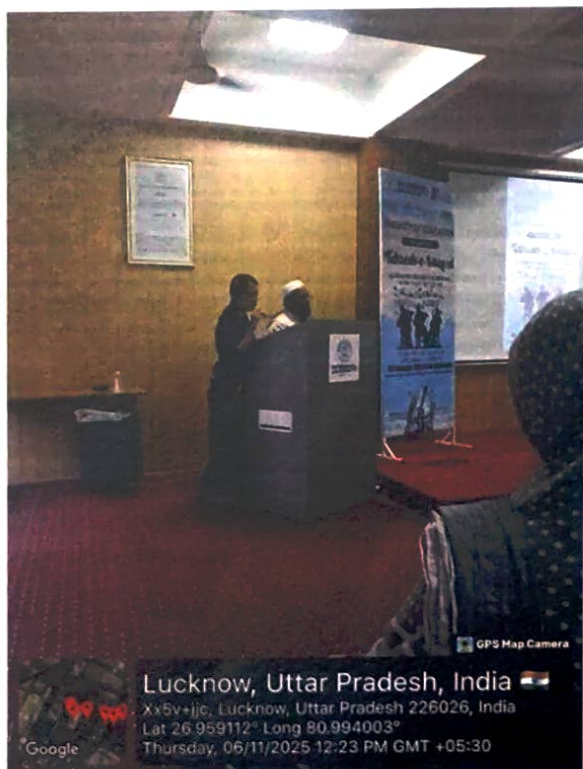
