Debate Competition on the Theme: "Sustainable Development through Non-Violent Means: Gandhi's Vision for a Better Future"

The Faculty of Education, Integral University, Lucknow, conducted a Debate Competition on 8 November 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in Room W301B, Academic Block W (Phase II). Held offline with 19 participants, the event formed part of the Faculty's Literary Activities. Centred on the theme "Sustainable Development through Non-Violent Means: Gandhi's Vision for a Better Future," aiming to promote Gandhian values of peace, justice, and non-violence through meaningful student engagement.

The program commenced with the blessings of Prof. Dr. A. K. Lodi, Dean, followed by the rendition of Gandhiji's bhajan, "Vaishnav Jan To Tene Kahiye Je", sung by Dr. Noorain Anas, which set a serene and reflective atmosphere in the hall.

This was followed by the Opening Address delivered by Dr. E. Ahmad, Head, Department of Education, who highlighted the relevance of Gandhian values in the contemporary world. He also felicitated the judges—Dr. Sana Fatima Arshad, Assistant Professor, Department of Languages, and Dr. Smita Srivastava, Associate Professor, Department of Education, by presenting these saplings as a symbol of peace and sustainability.

The event was anchored by Dr. Sania Kulsum, Event coordinator and Assistant Professor, Faculty of Education, who conducted the proceedings with thoughtful quotes and a graceful flow. She also outlined the rules of the debate and explained the evaluation criteria before the commencement of the competition to the participants.

All together nineteen Students from various programs and departments including B.Ed., D.El.Ed., DECCE, B.Sc. Biotech, B.A. (Hons.) Psychology, Law, participated actively in the competition. Participants expressed their views for and against the motion, presenting powerful arguments on how non-violence could serve as a path to achieving sustainable development. The event featured participants speaking in three languages — English, Hindi, and Urdu — reflecting linguistic diversity and inclusivity. A highlight of the event was the Rebuttal Round, which saw a spirited exchange of ideas between Ashhar Saleem (B.Ed. 2nd Year) and Ujjwal Singh (B.Sc. Biotech 1st Year). Their engaging rebuttal added depth and dynamism to the session.

After careful evaluation by the panel of judges, the winners were announced as follows:

First Prize: Shoaib Akhtar-B.Ed. 2nd Year

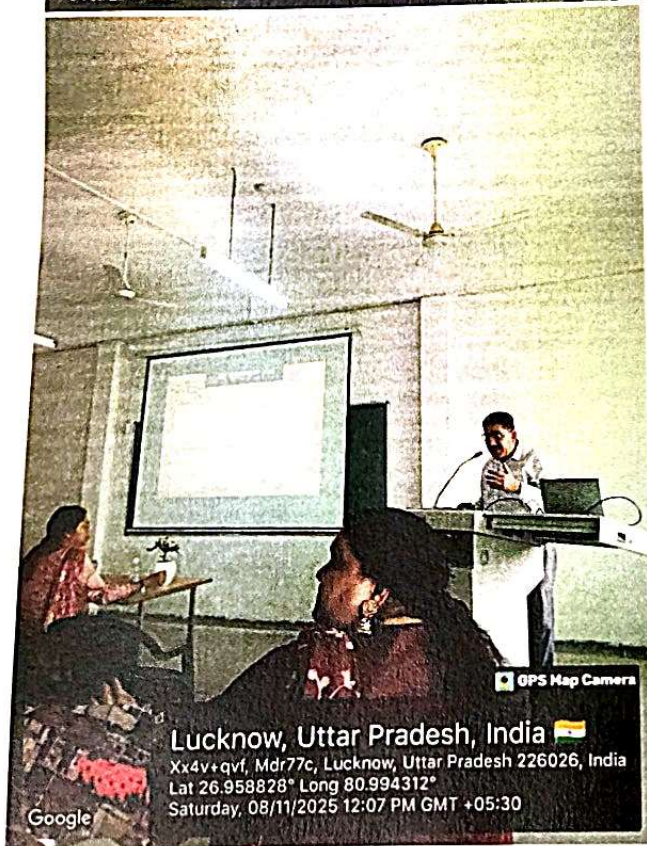
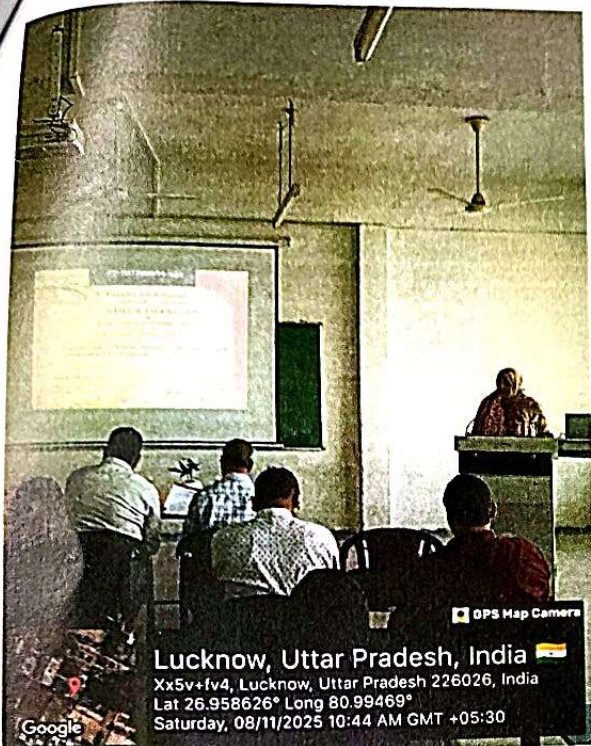
Second Prize: Himanshu Gupta-D.El.Ed. 2nd Year

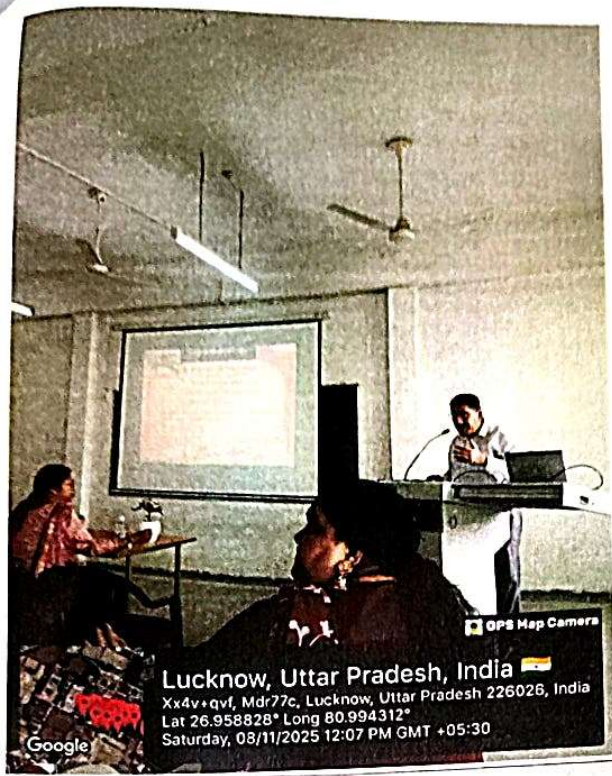
