DO's

- Before experimenting read the instrument manual carefully.
- Always perform the experiment or work as directed by the teacher/instructor.
- Don't forget to bring a calculator, graph sheet and other accessories when you come to the laboratory.
- Students must stay away from the yellow strip marked around the machines/apparatus while the machine is running.
- Maintain silence in the laboratory.

DON'Ts

- Absolutely no running, practical jokes or horseplay is allowed in the laboratories.
- The use of personal audio or video equipment is prohibited in the laboratory.
- Do not play with valves, screws and nuts of any apparatus.
- In the absence of an instructor, no student shall be allowed to work in the laboratory.
- Shoes must cover the entire foot. Open-toed shoes and sandals are inappropriate footwear in laboratories.
- Don't use mobile phones during lab hours.
