It serves as the significant data hub, with the goal of developing a comprehensive database of resources relevant to the institute's instructors and pupils, and facilitates the effective transfer of knowledge. Thus, all departmental staff, instructors, and students are permitted to access the library's resources.

The Civil Engineering Department Library spreads over an area of 62 square feet with seating capacity of 30 users and has a significant collection of 3097 books, 35 e-books, 7 digital databases, 6 subscribed printed journals, 5 subscribed online journals, Magazines, Industrial training reports, Dictionaries, News Letters and Patronizes Newspapers to comply with the demands and requirements of the faculty as well as students. Departmental library is well-stocked with the most recent editions of works by prominent writers by taking educational needs, Information needs, Inspiration needs and recreational needs into consideration. Project thesis (B.Tech, M.Tech) of past academic years are being maintained. Library is fully automated and about 135 users visit department library every month.
