# Analysis of Feedback:

The Student's responses to the proposed changes in the curriculum against different parameters were analysed. Based on their feedback the following points were captured.

- 67% of the students rated the curriculum "Excellent" with respect to professional competencies, intended outcomes, sequencing of the contents, adequacy of textbooks and reference materials mentioned in syllabi, and will add competitiveness through active engagement among learners and will also helps in carrier progression.
- While remaining thought that syllabus is about 26% very good but few replied that syllabus is moderate and poor.
