

Internal Quality Assurance Cell Department of Pharmacy Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report (Department of Pharmacy - 2021-2022)

Integral University has a unique culture of inclusiveness, diversity, personal and intellectual integrity and value-based education. The curriculum has a strong focus on individual growth and the development of essential tools so that its students make a mark in the corporate world and the field of technology.

Curriculum, being one of the significant aspects of the teaching learning process, needs continuous and periodical evaluation. In this regard, University uses a stakeholder based feedback process that focuses on the curriculum. This helps for continuous improvement and enrichment of the curriculum. The main purpose of this quality practice is to collect the stakeholders' perceptions in view of the effectiveness of the curriculum.

Feedback is collected from the University stakeholders: Student, Teacher, Alumni and Employer. It is carried out in different modes like offline feedback, by collecting feedback views on hardcopies, online feedback through Google forms, institute's LMS portal and written feedback through E-mails.

The collective feedback of all the stakeholders was analysed and a consolidated report of the recommendations is prepared. Feedback was taken against 8 questions. The first 7 questions have been rigoursly designed to capture the qualitative characteristics of the curriculum and its enrichment. The last question is a subjective question which captures the suggestions of the stakeholders. The questions recorded stakeholder views against professional competencies, sequencing of the content, adequacy of syllabi coverage & credit allocation, adequateness of textbooks and reference materials, syllabus in terms of active engagement of students, depth of the syllabus with respect to industry/global scenarios, and suggestion by the stakeholder. The stakeholders have recorded a positive feedback and have shown satisfaction regarding the curriculum. The responses have been collated and the suggestions and necessary revisions/ additions in the syllabi are captured in the feedback analysis report. The Feedback Analysis Report is submitted to the IQAC for necessary activities.

Text Suggestions:

- Introduction, revision, and/or modification of the study and evaluation scheme to make certain elective courses as departmental core subjects, as there is a need to study them for GPAT and other competitive examinations, and also because there is a technological need for the same. A proposal can be submitted to PCI.
- Practical Labs with advanced equipment's should be setup.
- Introduction of few practical courses based on industry trends.
- Organizing workshops, guest lectures and seminars related to the current trends of Pharmaceutical sciences.
- Active interactions with alumni was requested to bring help the students for career guidance and mentorship.

Analysis of Feedback:

The Student's responses to the proposed changes in the curriculum against different parameters were analysed. Based on their feedback the following points were captured.

- Majority of the students rated the curriculum "Excellent" with respect to professional
 competencies, intended outcomes, sequencing of the contents, adequacy of textbooks and
 reference materials mentioned in syllabi, and will add competitiveness through active
 engagement among learners and will also help in career progression. A few rated it to be very
 good.
 - Only few students rated it as moderate for the depth of the syllabus in relation to the competencies expected by industry/global scenarios.

Action Plan:

The analysis suggests that students' desires more focus on experimental learning. This can be improved by introducing more experiments and other experimental learning components.

- The practicality of the syllabi shall be enhanced for active engagement.

(2021-22)

A meeting of the departmental DQAC members was held on 14 August, 2021. In this meeting the feedback analysis report submitted was discussed. After intense deliberations, the DQAC made the following recommendations as the Action Taken Report which was submitted to the BOS committee for further decision on revision and or addition of proposed syllabi. The following proposals were made in the meeting.

Introduction of new ordinance and syllabus of Diploma in Pharmacy as per PCI notification was discussed where Introduction and implementation of study and evaluation scheme of D. Pharm first year along with syllabus as per ER 20, was also discussed. As per suggestion, the members discussed and approved it to be forwarded to Board of studies for further process.

The members also discussed the list of courses offered in new syllabus of D. Pharm program with focus on employability, entrepreneurship and skills and approved the same for forwarding to the BOS committee.

The DQAC activity calendar was planned for the session 2021-22 where it was decided that the following activities will be organized in the department of Pharmacy.

- Guest Lectures shall be organized especially with people from industries preferably our own Alumni.
- At least two activities shall be organized for extension and outreach.
- An awareness program shall be conducted with full participation of the students.
- Introduction of value -added courses for skill development.
- Programmes shall be taken up involving Inter Institutional Collaboration.

Based on the feedback analysis, the committee discussed all the agenda items and recommended it for further approval in B.O.S and F.B.
